A ski tour from Vienna to Menton in 3 months across the Alps. More than 80000m of height difference, and 1200km in distance.



A Project : The Snowpack

Three months on our skis, three months of being confronted with avalanche safety decisions on a day to day basis.

After 16 years of ski mountaineering, and 14 years as a ski patroller, Vincent will put his knowledge of the snow into practice.

This is a unique opportunity for him to build on his snow stability evaluation skills.

This trip is complementary to his career as Avalanche Control Operations Manager . For risk management purposes we will be applying the Münter* method when possible.



Münter System: an avalanche risk management system using various criterias (snow, weather, terrain, human factors) evaluated at different moments (the day before, on departure, on location)

Ethics and Logistics:

1) Itinerary:

- We are planning to be on our skis as much as possible, but in order to connect certain massifs, we will use other forms of transport for a few kilometers.
- For every stage we have analysed the risks on 1/25000 scale maps with one or more possible itineraries for each.

2) We are travelling light:

- We are a team of two and are aiming to move rapidly, with ease of movement.
- The distance is long and winter only allows us a few months for the journey, speed is essential.



3) To travel Light:

- We will be staying in huts and refuges.
- There will be 10 meeting points all along our planed itinerary to reload food, and change clothes and maps; thanks to our logistic team.
- We will be using the most lightweight equipment possible.

We have been training all year long by practicing our favourite sports (Ski Mountaineering, Alpine Climbing, rock climbing, mountain biking...)
